Maintain Your Credential

The SHRM recertification process is about more than just renewing your credential. It's a way to up your game and take your professional expertise to the next level. There are two ways to recertify:

1. Earn 60 professional development credits (PDCs) within your three-year recertification cycle

OR


2. Retake the SHRM certification exam.

You must complete one of these options by your recertification end date (last day of your birth month).

Recertify the only credentials supported by SHRM, your career development partner.

THREE SIMPLE STEPS



ENTER your professional development activities in your SHRM Certification Portal.

Log in to your SHRM Certification
Portal at portal.shrm.org and indicate
whether you have an activity code
or not. If you have a code, enter it. If
you do not have a code, select a PDC
category (Advance Your Education,
Advance Your Organization or Advance
Your Profession) and enter the activity
information.



SUBMIT your completed recertification record as early as one year into your recertification cycle.



PAY the recertification processing fee.

- Recertify early and begin earning for the next cycle right away.
- 60+ PDCs is all you need, but if you earn more, carry over up to 20 additional credits to your new cycle.
- Can't complete the process by your end date? Take advantage of the 60-day grace period to get it done.
